- Congratulations to everyone on outstanding Winter Concerts in December!! We are very proud of our students for their growth as musicians and excellent performances!
  - We are looking forward to the Jazz Winter Concert next Tuesday, Jan. 13 at 7:00pm. This will feature the JH and SH Jazz Bands.
  - 18 Senior High students represent Hollidaysburg at the Blair County Band Festival at Tyrone High School on Jan. 28 & 29, 2026. This is the same time and location as the JH County Band festival.
  - 15 students represent Hollidaysburg at the PMEA District 6 Band Festival at Cambria Heights HS on Feb. 4 - 6, 2026. The students will be staying in Ebensburg.
  - The U.S. Navy Concert Band and Sea Chanters will be performing a free concert at the SH Auditorium on Thursday, Feb. 19 at 7:00pm.
  - We welcome Mr. Aaron Kaufman from Penn State University who will student teaching with Mrs. Lori Stephens at CWL and Mr. Sheehan at the SH. He started today!!
  - Performance evaluations/auditions will take place for SH Bands next month.
  - SH Spring Trip will likely be to Cleveland or New York City.
  - Mr. Sheehan has assembled a committee for the 100 th Anniversary celebration of the band that will happen next school year. More information will be shared at the Feb. HAMPA meeting.
  - The new wrap for the Trailer will happen in the Spring. We have secured 3 donors to contribute \$500 per year for 3 years.
